

## FORT WILLIAM (AN GEARASDAN)

Fort William, the largest town in the Highlands and situated at the south end of the Great Glen, lies in the shadow of Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain. This area is a fine location to use as a base to discover the Highlands.

## GLENFINNAN (GLEAN FHIONGHAIN)

We cross the 21-arched Glenfinnan Viaduct (a location made famous in the 'Harry Potter' films) which overlooks Loch Shiel and the Jacobite monument. The train may pause here, time permitting, to allow you to take in the magnificent view. Once stopped in Glenfinnan Station, there will be time to stretch your legs and, if you wish, visit the West Highland Railway Museum located in the restored station building. 'The Jacobite' may also stop at Arisaig by request to the guard.

## MALLAIG (MALAIG)

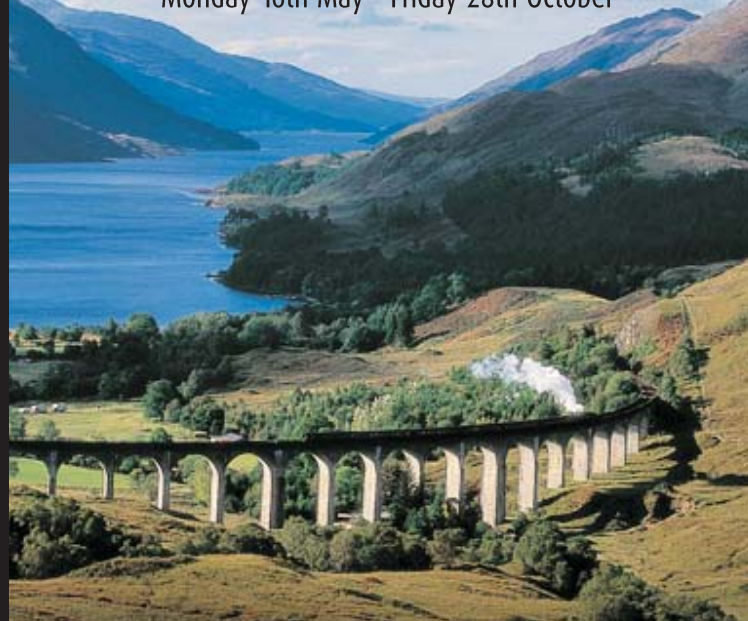

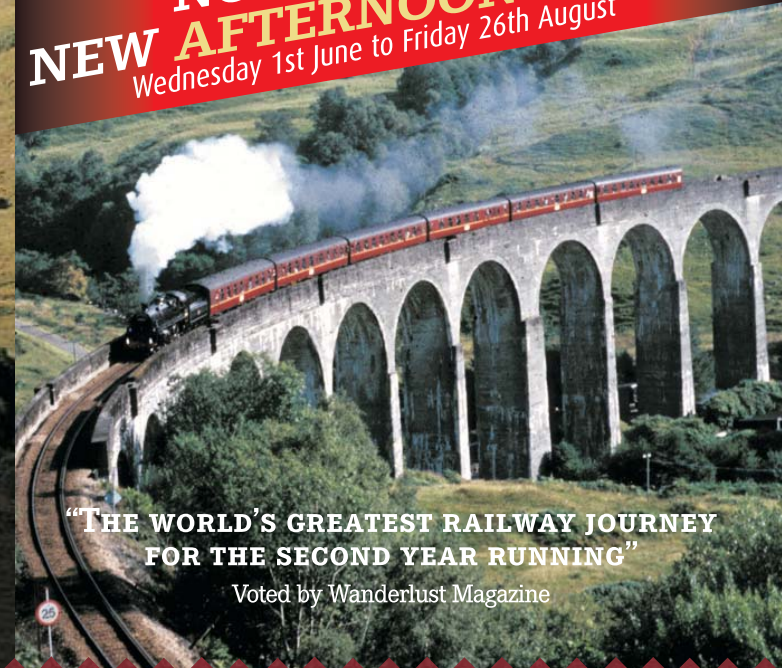

## THE JOURNEY

### FORT WILLIAM TO MALLAIG

We would like to welcome you aboard 'The Jacobite' steam train service from Fort William to Mallaig, now in its 28th year! The Jacobite is regarded as one of the Greatest Railway Journeys in the World, due mainly to the breathtaking scenery. The 84 mile round trip will take you past Britain's highest mountain, deepest loch, shortest river and most Westerly station.

On departing from Fort William you might first catch a glimpse of Ben Nevis, clouds permitting. In a few minutes, look out for the flight of eight lochs known as 'Neptune's Staircase' as we slowly cross the bridge over the Caledonian Canal at Banavie. The level run along the shores of Loch Eil is followed by a steady climb up to the famous Glenfinnan viaduct (scenes made famous in the acclaimed Harry Potter films). If time permits your driver will slow down here to allow you to take in the magnificent views of Loch Shiel and the Glenfinnan Monument which marks the site where Prince Charles Edward Stuart raised his father's Standard in 1745. Our Jacobite acknowledges it's namesake.

Leaving Arisaig, Britain's most Westerly station (let the guard know if you wish to alight here), the railway passes Britain's deepest loch, Loch Morar, and shortest river, River Morar. You will be treated to views of the sea and the inner Hebridean islands; the small isles of Rum, Eigg, Muck and Canna, often shimmering like jewels on the horizon.

From the comfort of your seat, see the untamed beauty of Lochaber and beyond. Be it summer or early Autumn, there is always plenty to see. Even when the weather is not at its best, 'The Jacobite' steam train provides an ideal way to see the wonderful West Highlands.



## FOLLOWING HARRY POTTER

### ALONG THE ROAD TO THE ISLES

## HOW TO GET TO FORT WILLIAM

- By car from the South: From Carlisle, take the M6 & M74 to Glasgow. Follow the A82 from Glasgow. From Edinburgh take the M9 to Stirling then the A84, A85 (to Crianlarich) & A82 to Fort William.
- By car from the North: From Aviemore take the A9 and A86 or from Inverness, the A82.
- By Train from Edinburgh or Glasgow via the West Highland Line. Telephone 08457 48 49 50 for timetables and fares.
